Highways England: Resurfacing M5 northbound junction 20 – junction 19

Highways England will be carrying out essential resurfacing on the M5 northbound, between junctions 20 and 19. **Work will start on Monday 9 October 2017.** The resurfacing work will take approximately **8 weeks** to complete. Every effort will be made to ensure impacts on the local community is kept to the minimum.

To ensure the safety of the workforce and road users as work is carried out it is necessary to put a traffic management system in place. The majority of the work will be completed under lane closures. However a number of night-time closures (between **8pm and 6am**) are needed to complete the work:

- **Total Closure of the M5 Northbound** between Junction 20 and Junction 19 will be on the 12, 26, 27 October, 06, 07, 10 & 13 November.
- Total closure of the **northbound entry slip road** M5 Junction 20 on; 09, 10, 13, 16 Oct & 27 Nov
- Total closure of the **M5 northbound, between the exit slip road and the entry slip road** at Junction 20; 30, 31 Oct, 01, 08 & 22 November.

Whilst these closures are in force, fully signed diversion routes will be in place.
